Entry Divisions: REMINDER!! STUDENTS ENTERING THE SONATA DIVISION MAY CHOOSE TO PLAY ONE MOVEMENT,

TWO MOVEMENTS OR A COMPLETE WORK.

Sonatina Classical period through composers born no later than 1860.

Two movements from the same sonatina are required. They do not need to be contrasting movements.

Sonata Classical period through modern.

- ONE MOVEMENT or
- TWO MOVEMENTS or They do not need to be contrasting movements.
- COMPLETE WORK

Movements must be from the same work.

Students may enter either Sonatina or Sonata... not both divisions.

All compositions must be performed from memory. Repeats may not be used.

*New for 2024......You will need to bring a copy of your music with the measures numbered for the judges.
No photocopies, please!

Time Limitations: 20 MINUTE LIMIT FOR COMPLETE WORKS! 12 MINUTE LIMIT FOR TWO MOVEMENTS!

Ratings: All participants will be rated on a scale of 1-10 by each of two judges.

Scheduling: Audition schedules are based on the performance times that you submit.

Please be sure that these times are accurate! Audition times are arranged by age groups.

Repertoire notes: Mozart K. 545 & Beethoven Op. 49 will be accepted in either category

Haydn Hob. XVI/1, 7, 8, 9, 10 & 11 are considered to be Sonatinas.
